

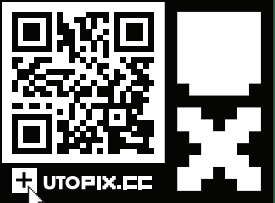

SHORT PAY, ALL OUT! For 63 days, thousands of female textile workers, most of them immigrants, dropped their needles and took to the streets of Lawrence, MA (USA). The workers rejected wage cuts and long work hours. Though they were repressed and demonized, they held firm until their demands were met.
